- WATER PLANT:
 - > Employees successfully thawed 4 frozen water lines throughout the village.
 - Discussed & reviewed a study/evaluation plan prepared by Tom Borck of Poggemeyer Design Group (PDG). The 2 phase plan for major upgrades and/or improvements would cost approximately \$919,000.00.
- SEWER PLANT:
 - It was discovered that the wiring box was not sealed properly on the Lower 40 lift station, which allowed steam to enter the wiring box and freeze. All work to correct the issue is covered by warranty.
- ELECTRIC DEPT:
 - No report
- STREETS:
 - > Two snow events both handled very efficiently.
- PARKS & REC:

- PROJECTS:
 - Solar Planet contractors have repaired the north and south sections of panels that were out for several weeks. The entire field is functioning.
- OTHER:
 - The Village of Gibsonburg will be receiving an antenna from the World Trade Center memorabilia. The antenna will become a permanent display in their Memorial Park. We are working with Gibsonburg on different ways to display the antenna prior to its permanent placement in the Park. Depending on the arrival date, the piece could be displayed and/or be a part of our 4th of July celebration and parade.
 - Extended Bennett Stampers probation 90 days. Bennett has concentrated on certification in the Water Plant and needs to work on learning other duties in all departments.
