ORDINANCE #13-2009

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH <u>TIMMONS EQUIPMENT</u> FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A 2009 COBALT MOWER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio desires to purchase a 2009 Cobalt riding mower for the Village of Woodville from Timmons Equipment, and

WHEREAS, the Village currently owns a 2004 Stallion riding mower which is no longer needed by the Village, and

WHEREAS, Timmons Equipment will accept as trade in, the Village of Woodville's 2004 Stallion riding mower;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. Robert Rickard as the Village Administrator of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio is hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to execute an agreement to purchase from Timmons Equipment of Fremont, Ohio a 2009 Cobalt 27hp w 61 riding mower for the Village of Woodville, and to allow for trade in, to depreciate the cost of the Cobalt, a 2004 Stallion riding mower for a total cost difference not to exceed \$5,175.00.

Section 2. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to purchase the 2009 Cobalt riding mower to provide necessary lawn maintenance services for the Village of Woodville.

Section 3.It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken at an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal regulations including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
