

ORDINANCE #21-2009

**AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A
CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR
THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDING TO DEVELOP A SAFE ROUTES
TO SCHOOL (SRTS) PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Federal Government is providing funding for the development of a School Travel Plan (STP) through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation (ODOT); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio wishes to enter into contract with ODOT to provide the funding necessary to develop a School Travel Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that:

Section 1: James R. Rickard as the Village Administrator of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio is hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to enter into a contract with the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation in substantially the same form now on file with the Clerk-Treasurer.

Section 2: The total cost for the School Travel Plan is estimated to be \$1,000.00. ODOT shall provide to the Village of Woodville 100% of the eligible costs, up to a maximum of \$1,000.00 in Federal funds. The Village of Woodville further agrees to pay 100% of the cost over and above the maximum amount provided by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to meet funding deadlines.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio "Revised Code.
