

ORDINANCE #30-2009

AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH UNIFIRST CORPORATION FROM OCTOBER 1, 2009 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2011 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, UniFirst Corporation provides a service to supply uniforms for personnel, floor mats, and towels; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio desires to enter into contract with UniFirst Corporation to provide uniforms for personnel, floor mats, and towels;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that:

Section 1: James R. Rickard as the Village Administrator of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio is hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to enter into a contract with UNIFIRST CORPORATION in substantially the same form now on file with the Clerk-Treasurer for two years. Commencing on October 1, 2009.

Section 2: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to provide uniform services for the Village of Woodville personnel.


Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio "Revised Code.
