ORDINANCE #4-2009

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REGULAR VILLAGE COUNCIL MEETINGS ON THE SECOND AND FOURTH MONDAY OF EACH MONTH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio currently holds its regular meetings on the 1st and 3rd Mondays of each month at 7:00p.m., and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village wishes to change it regular meetings to the 2nd and 4th Mondays of each month at 7:00p.m.,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that:

Section 1: Regular Council meetings of the Village of Woodville shall be held on the second and fourth Mondays of each month at 7:00p.m. beginning February 23, 2009.

Section 2: Any provision of any Ordinance conflicting with this Ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to change the regular meeting dates so as to insure the availability of the Village Solicitor.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
