ORDINANCE #5-2009

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TEASURER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S CONTRACT FOR SODIUM CHLORIDE

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio wishes to purchase sodium chloride (rock salt) for the 2009-2010 winter season, and

WHEREAS, Section 5513.01(B) of the Ohio Revised Code provides the opportunity for Municipal Corporations to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purchase of machinery, material, supplies, or other articles, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Woodville. Ohio has determined that it would be beneficial for the said Village to participate in said program;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that:

Section 1: Richard A. Harman as Mayor, and Barbara J. Runion as Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio are hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio to execute an agreement substantially in the form now on file with the Clerk-Treasurer allowing the Village of Woodville, Ohio to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's Contract for Sodium Chloride.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
