

ORDINANCE #16-2010

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, CLERK-TREASURER, AND VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE REAL PROPERTY IN WOODVILLE TOWNSHIP, SANDUSKY COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio desires to purchase real estate from Thomas E. Linke and Christine B. Linke, Co-Trustees of the Thomas E. Linke and Christine B. Linke Trust for the development of new well fields, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio has negotiated an agreement for such purpose.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WOODVILLE, SANDUSKY COUNTY, OHIO that:

1. Richard A. Harman as Mayor, Barbara J. Runion as Clerk-Treasurer, and James R. Rickard as Village Administrator of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio are hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to execute a Purchase Agreement with the said contract to be in substantially the same form now on file with the Clerk of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, the purchase price not to exceed \$18,000.00.
2. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to purchase this property so the Village can proceed with the development of the new well field.
3. All formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of the Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
