AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF WOODVILLE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, VARIOUS ORDINANCES OF A GENERAL AND PERMANENT NATURE HAVE BEEN PASSED WHICH SHOULD BE INCLUDED IN THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF WOODVILLE, OHIO;

WHEREAS, NUMEROUS SECTIONS IN THE TRAFFIC, GENERAL OFFENSES AND FIRE PREVENTION CODES NEED TO BE UPDATED SO AS TO CONFORM TO ENACTMENTS OF THE OHIO GENERAL ASSEMBLY;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WOODVILLE OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the ordinances of Woodville, Ohio of a general and permanent nature as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, titles, chapters and sections within the 2010 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances are hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 4: All formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Ohio R.C. 121.22.

SECTION 5: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and for the further reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of the Codified Ordinances to the officials and residents of the Village, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid practical legal entanglements.
