A Resolution Pursuant To Section 5705.03 Of The Revised Code Requesting The Sandusky County Auditor Certify To The Village Of Woodville, Ohio The Current Tax Valuation Of The Village Of Woodville, Ohio And The Dollar Amount Of Revenue That Would Be Generated By A Renewal Of A Seven And Four Tenths (7.4) Mill Tax Levy For Current Expenses As Authorized By Section 5705.19 Of The Revised Code.

Section 1; The Council of The Village of Woodville, Ohio has determined that the revenue which will be raised by all tax levies which this Council is authorized to impose will be insufficient to provide for the current expenses of the Village, and it is, therefore, necessary to submit to voters at the election to be held May 3, 2011 the question of the renewal of an existing tax levy in excess of the ten mill limitation to provide for current expenses for the tax years 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015.

Section 2: That pursuant to Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Council of the Village of Woodville, Ohio hereby requests that the Sandusky County Auditor certify to the said Council the total current tax valuation of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal of an existing seven and four tenths (7.4) mill levy in excess of the ten mill limitation for the purpose of paying the current expenses of the Village of Woodville.

Section 3: That the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village be and is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify a copy of this resolution to the Sandusky County Auditor in order to obtain the information necessary to submit the renewal of an existing tax levy to the electors of said Village at the election to be held May 3, 2011.

Section 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
