ORDINANCE #2-2010

AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH CRIMINAL JUSTICE COORDINATING COUNCIL FOR THE 2010 CALENDAR YEAR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council provides criminal justice information services through the Northwest Ohio Regional Information System (hereinafter referred to as NORIS): and

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio desires to make the information services of NORIS available to the agencies and employees within its jurisdiction: and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that:

Section 1: James R. Rickard of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio is hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to enter into an agreement with NORIS in substantially the same form now on file with the Clerk-Treasurer for one year. Commencing on January 1, 2010.

Section 2: The Village agrees to pay \$9,885.00 after January 1, 2010.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to provide information services to the Police Department.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section121.22 of the Ohio "Revised Code.
