

ORDINANCE #25-2010

**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR THE
VILLAGE OF WOODVILLE ADMINISTRATOR AND REQUIRING TOWNSHIP OF
WOODVILLE RESIDENCY**

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code 735.271 requires that a Village Administrator become a resident of the Village within six months of appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio wishes to waive said residency requirement for its Village Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio wishes to require said residency to be within the Township of Woodville;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that:

Section 1: The residency requirement established by Ohio Revised Code 735.271 mandating that the Village Administrator become a Village resident is waived.

Section 2: The Village Administrator must reside within the Township of Woodville.


