

ORDINANCE # 4-2011

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SOUTHEASTERN EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A 2011 CASE 580SN BACKHOE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio desires to purchase a 2011 Case 580SN backhoe for the Village of Woodville from Southeastern Equipment Company, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville participates in the State Cooperative Purchasing Program and Southeastern Equipment Company recognizes this program and will also accept as trade in, the Village of Woodville's 2004 Case 580SM backhoe;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that:


Section 1. Keith Kruse as the Village Administrator of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio is hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to execute and agreement to purchase from Southeastern Equipment Company of Perrysburg, Ohio a 2011 Case 580SN backhoe for the Village of Woodville, and to allow for trade in and the State Purchasing Program discount to depreciate the cost of the 2011 Case 580SN backhoe for a total cost difference not to exceed \$31,036.67.

Section 2. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to purchase the 2011 Case 580SN backhoe to provide necessary maintenance services for the Village of Woodville.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions on the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken at an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberation of this Council were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal regulations including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
