

ORDINANCE #8-2012

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #3-2012

WHEREAS, Ordinance #3-2012 contained a clerical error in referring to the purchase of a 2012 Dodge Charger vehicle from Coughlin Cars of Marysville, Ohio, when the intention of Council was to authorize the purchase of a 2011 Dodge Charger, and

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that:

Section 1. Keith Kruse, as the Village Administrator of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio is hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to execute an agreement to purchase from Coughlin Cars of Marysville, Ohio a 2011 Dodge Charger vehicle for the Village of Woodville, and to allow for trade in, to depreciate the cost of the 2011 Dodge Charger, a 2008 Dodge Charger for a total cost difference not to exceed \$22,500.00.


Section 2. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to purchase the 2011 Dodge Charger to provide necessary public safety services for the Village of Woodville.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken at an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal regulations including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
