

ORDINANCE #14-2013

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING TWO (2) 2000 GMC 1500 ½ TON PICKUPS, A 1994 FORD F250 ¾ TON PICKUP, AND A 1990 RCT UTILITY TRAILER

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio desires to purchase two (2) 2000 GMC 1500 ½ ton pickups, a 1994 FORD F250 ¾ ton pickup, and a 1990 RCT utility trailer from the Ohio Department of Transportation, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation has offered the aforementioned vehicles and utility trailer for purchase;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. Keith Kruse, as the Village Administrator of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio is hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to execute an agreement to purchase two (2) 2000 GMC 1500 ½ ton pickups at a cost of \$1,359.40 each, a 1994 FORD F250 ¾ ton pickup at a cost of \$1,205.30, and a 1990 RCT utility trailer at a cost of \$129.50 from the Ohio Department of Transportation for a total cost of all not to exceed \$4,053.60.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken at an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal regulations including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
