ORDINANCE #25 - 2013

EMPLOYING ROBERT A. KUHLMAN AS VILLAGE SOLICITOR

WHEREAS, The Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, wishes to employ legal counsel, and

WHEREAS, the present Solicitor's appointment expires on December 31, 2013;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, that:

- 1. Robert A. Kuhlman is hereby employed as Village Solicitor from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 at a salary of \$22,500.00. Said salary shall be paid to Robert A. Kuhlman monthly in the amount of \$1,875.00/month.
- 2. The Village shall withhold Robert A. Kuhlman's monthly health insurance premium of \$1,536.93 from said monthly salary of \$1,875.00 through a section 125 plan deduction. Should the health insurance premium increase during the term hereof, the Village shall be responsible for paying that portion of the premium exceeding the sum of \$1,536.93/month. Should the health insurance premium decrease, Robert A. Kuhlman shall be entitled to receive the decreased amount.
- 3. Robert A. Kuhlman will be a member of the Public Employees Retirement System, with the Village being responsible for making the employer's contribution thereto.
- 4. Robert A. Kuhlman shall attend at least 16 Village Council meetings and provide general legal representation for the Village, including the prosecution of criminal cases in the County Court. Robert A. Kuhlman shall be paid \$150.00 per hour in addition to the aforesaid salary for representation of the Village in litigation proceedings as the parties understand that the time spent in litigation of cases is unpredictable and varies significantly from year to year.
- 5. All formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements. including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
