ORDINANCE #12-2014

AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH MIDWEST COMPOST INC. FOR THE EXCAVATION AND DISPOSAL OF SPENT LIME MATERIAL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Midwest Compost Inc. provides excavation and disposal, via land application, of lime material services; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio desires to excavate approximately 8,315 cubic yards of spent lime and dispose of said lime material by land application for agricultural purposes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that:

Section 1: Keith E. Kruse, Village Administrator of the Village of Woodville. Sandusky County, Ohio is hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to enter into an agreement with MIDWEST COMPOST INC. in substantially the same form now on file with the Fiscal Officer for an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00.

Section 2: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to eradicate lime materials to protect the contiguous land.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section121.22 of the Ohio "Revised Code.
