ORDINANCE #20-2014

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH REINEKE FORD LINCOLN FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A 2015 FORD INTERCEPTOR UTILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio desires to purchase a 2015 Ford Interceptor Utility vehicle for the Village of Woodville's Police Department from Reineke Ford Lincoln, and

WHEREAS, Reineke Ford Lincoln of Findlay has a 2015 Ford Interceptor Utility vehicle for immediate delivery, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Woodville wishes to repeal Ordinance #16-2014 in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. Keith Kruse, as the Village Administrator of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio is hereby authorized and directed for and in the name of the Village of Woodville, Ohio and on its behalf to execute an agreement to purchase from Reineke Ford Lincoln, Findlay, Ohio a 2015 Ford Interceptor Utility vehicle for the Village of Woodville for a total cost not to exceed \$33,500.00.

Section 2. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to purchase the 2015 Ford Interceptor Utility vehicle to provide necessary public safety services for the Village of Woodville.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken at an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal regulations including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
