ORDINANCE #3 – 2014

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 951.04(a), PLACING TRASH FOR PICK-UP. OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF WOODVILLE

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio previously adopted a Garbage and Refuse Code pursuant to Part 9 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Woodville; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio wishes to amend Section 951.04(a) Placing Trash For Pick-Up, of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1: 951.04(a) of the Village of Woodville Codified Ordinances which presently read as follows:

No person shall cause or allow trash, garbage, rubbish, refuse or any other noxious or offensive (a) materials or substances to be placed upon his/her premises or place of business or residence for purpose of refuse pickup earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the day immediately preceding a scheduled refuse collection day.

be amended to read as follows:

No person shall cause or allow trash, garbage, rubbish, refuse or any other noxious or offensive materials or substances to be placed upon his/her premises or place of business or residence for purpose of refuse pickup earlier than 5:00 p.m. on the day immediately preceding a scheduled refuse collection day. After refuse pickup, any refuse containers and any other items not removed by the refuse hauler, shall be removed from pickup site no later than twenty-four hours after the scheduled pickup.

SECTION 2. All former provisions of any ordinance inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
