A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE SANDUSKY COUNTY MULTIJURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Sandusky County; and

WHEREAS, Sandusky County has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as **SANDUSKY COUNTY MULTIJURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN** of March 13, 2015 in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the **SANDUSKY COUNTY MULTIJURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN** identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Sandusky County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the Council for the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio demonstrates our commitment to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the SANDUSKY COUNTY MULTIJURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN of March 13, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WOODVILLE, SANDUSKY COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Village Council shall go on record, as they will adopt the **SANDUSKY COUNTY MULTIJURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**, as their own.
