ORDINANCE #19-2016

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR A GIFT OF APPRECIATION TO ALL VILLAGE EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is desirable to promote continued good working relations between the employees of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, and the officials of the Village; and

WHEREAS, a thirty-five dollar gift certificate to a Village of Woodville Business would be an appropriate means of showing appreciation to the employees of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to present this gift certificate during the holiday season;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio that:

Section 1: Barbara J. Runion as Fiscal Officer of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio is authorized to expend the necessary funds to pay Village of Woodville Businesses for gift certificates for full time and permanent part time Village Employees in the amount of \$35.00 each.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that it is necessary, and desirable to present these gift certificates during the holiday season; therefore it must be authorized and arranged for immediately. Said Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage by Council provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and signature of the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
