

ORDINANCE #3-2016

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF KEITH E. KRUSE AS THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 735.271 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Woodville has previously established the position of Village Administrator, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Keith E. Kruse as the Village of Woodville Administrator.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Village Council hereby approves the appointment of Keith E. Kruse as Village Administrator.

Section 2: The powers and duties of the Village Administrator shall be those as provided in Ohio Revised Code section 735.273.


Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the Village Administrator's contract expired on December 31, 2015 and therefore the Village Administrator appointment must be authorized and arranged for immediately. Said Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage by Council provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and signature of the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 4: All formal actions of the Council of the Village of Woodville, Sandusky County, Ohio, concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
